BACKGROUND

The School of Pharmacy supports Māori education in the field of pharmacy. The School is offering **two FEES ONLY** scholarships in any one academic year, for students enrolling in the Postgraduate Professional Programmes in the Postgraduate Certificate in Pharmacy (endorsed in Medicines Management). The Postgraduate Certificate comprises two papers: PHCX541 Medicines Information and PHCX542 Medicines Management. Interested persons should complete the application form available.

Scholarship awards will be made by an adjudicating panel comprising members of the School and the MPA.

Eligibility: Ordinary members of The Māori Pharmacists' Association.

DETAILS

A call for applications will be made in October for the following year, and again in May for the second semester. Applicants may choose to enrol in one or both papers per application. Should an applicant apply for only one paper, the applicant would be required to apply again on a second application round for a Scholarship for the next paper. An applicant can apply for the Scholarship only once per paper.
